BACKGROUND

A 36-year-old man sustained severe partial and full-thickness burns covering 76% of his body in an oil rig explosion. His care spanned 124 days in the hospital, including multiple surgeries and intensive burn treatments. The final itemized bill totaled \$7,329,156 across 328 pages of complex, fragmented data.

For most payors, a bill of this size and complexity represents massive financial risk. Fragmented revenue codes, duplicate charges, and vague cost structures make it difficult to know what's truly owed, and difficult to defend any payment decision without triggering provider disputes, negotiation, or even litigation.

THE SOLUTION

WellRithms deployed its AI-powered Itemized Bill Review system, backed by physician oversight, to digitize and analyze the entire bill line by line. The system flagged several irregular patterns, including implant charges that

were fragmented across multiple revenue codes, surgical materials that were billed repeatedly under separate and unrelated categories, and inflated pharmacy and supply charges that masked the true cost of care.

Key Finding:

- Billed for Implants & Supplies: \$5,032,256
- Verified Actual Cost: \$1,445,759
- Excess Charges Identified: \$3,586,497
