LINE-LEVEL MEDICAL BILL AUDIT

UCR REPRICING USING MARKET DATA

SBP reprices each billed service using a combination of standard payment benchmarks and state-specific market data, ensuring all recommendations reflect real-world reimbursement expectations.

In the absence of fee schedules, reimbursement decisions are often shaped by negotiation rather than accuracy. This creates wide variation across similar bills and exposes payors to unnecessary disputes.

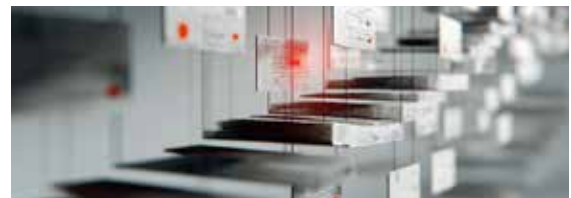

When applied correctly, this approach frequently results in significant reductions to billed charges, with savings of 60–80% off the billed amount observed in eligible UCR state bills.

Experienced physicians review services rendered to confirm accuracy, and appropriateness. Services not supported by documentation are corrected or removed.



PHYSICIAN OVERSIGHT AND VALIDATION

Bills are audited line by line rather than relying on them alone.
